### **House Natural Resources Committee Approves Fishing Access Bill:**

Congresswoman Ros-Lehtinen announced that on Thursday, October 8, the House Natural Resources Committee, voted 20 to 15, to approve an amendment to add the language of the Preserving Public Access to Public Waters Act (H.R. 3310) to the bipartisan Sportsmen's Heritage and Recreational Enhancement (SHARE) Act (H.R. 2406). H.R. 3310 was introduced by Reps. Ros-Lehtinen, Carlos Curbelo, and Mario Diaz-Balart, in part to address the National Park Service's blatant disregard for public access concerns raised in objection to the proposed no-fishing zone in Biscayne National Park. The approved amendment was introduced by Congresswoman Redewagen with the full support of Natural Resources Chairman Bishop.

Congresswoman Ros-Lehtinen further stated "By adding H.R. 3310 to the SHARE Act, we're one step closer to restoring the working trust and partnership necessary between the federal government, state wildlife agencies, and the American public, so that we can work together to tackle the real environmental challenges that threaten people's way of life and natural lands and waters on which we all depend."
